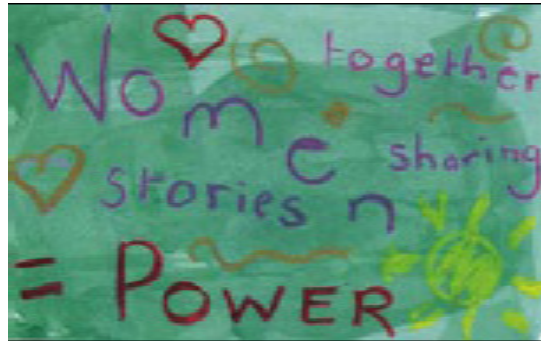




Victorian Women and Mental Health Network
